Newly added programs are also easily accessed via the **Latest additions** tab.

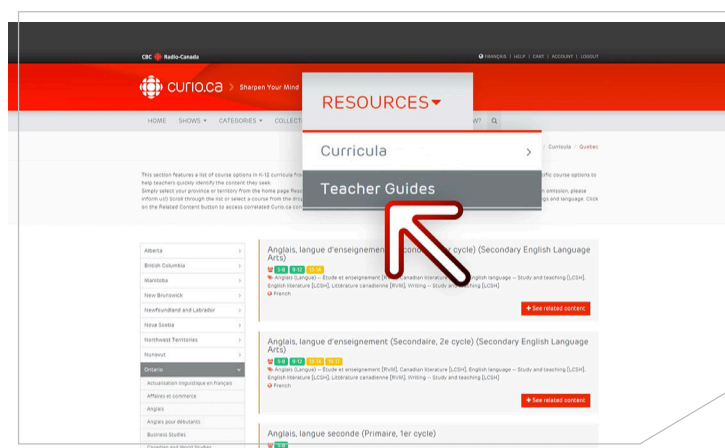


The **Resources** tab gives you ready access to primary and secondary school curricula for all provinces and territories.

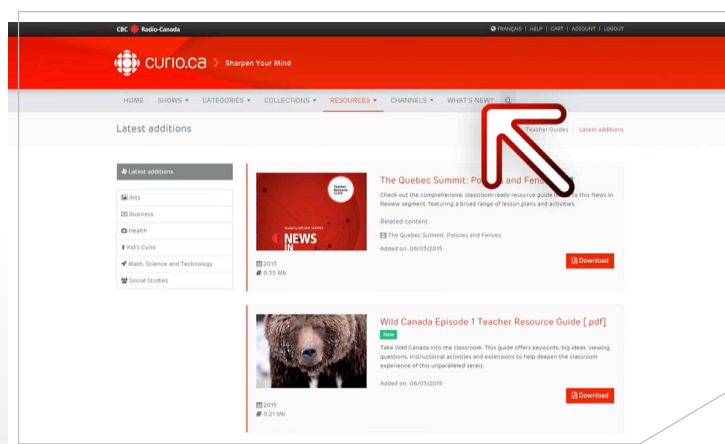
