

Parcours scholarships

Do you live in one of the census metropolitan areas (CMAs) of Montreal, Québec City, Sherbrooke, or Ottawa-Gatineau (Quebec side)? If so, you will receive an annual \$7,500 scholarship¹ if you are admitted in the first or the second round to one of the programs at our Cegep.

\$22,500

for a technical program

\$15,000

for a pre-university program

Applicants from elsewhere in Quebec may also be eligible for Parcours scholarships if their residential address at the time of registration is located more than sixty kilometers from a Cégep de la Gaspésie et des Îles campus or from another eligible Cegep offering the program of their choice.

Other admission requirements:

- be registered full-time;
- study in person on one of our campuses (distance learning students are not eligible);
- be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident, or have the refugee or protected person status;
- be considered a Quebec resident.

Lodging



Located on the campus itself, the Gaspé student residence hall has furnished single rooms. These are located either:

- in one of the 55 apartments, each with three to six rooms, a fully equipped kitchen, and a bathroom;
- or in one of the four pavilions, each with 20 to 25 rooms, a fully equipped kitchen, and two shared bathrooms per floor.

Please note that pavilions are for mixed occupancy and may therefore house both men and women.

French Immersion Option

The Gaspé campus offers several programs in French, providing an opportunity for immersion.

- English-speaking students holding a certificate of eligibility can opt for a French immersion in their specific training! In their case, general education² may be conducted in French or in English, along with the standard language test.
- In the case of English-speaking or allophone students not holding a certificate of eligibility, general education will take place in French, along with standard language test. The program will therefore be entirely in French.

In both cases, some restrictions apply.




