Parcours scholarships*

Do you live in one of the census metropolitan areas (CMAs) of Montreal, Québec City, Sherbrooke, or Ottawa-Gatineau (Quebec side)? If so, you could receive an annual \$7,500 scholarship¹ after your admission in the first round for most of our programs (see the list on our website)!

Applicants from elsewhere in Quebec may also be eligible for Parcours scholarships if their residential address at the time of registration is located more than sixty kilometers from a Cégep de la Gaspésie et des Îles campus or from another eligible Cégep offering the program of their choice.

Located on the campus itself, the Gaspé student residence hall has furnished single rooms. These are located either:

- in one of the 55 apartments, each with three to six rooms, a fully equipped kitchen, and a bathroom;
- or in one of the four pavilions, each with 20 to 25 rooms, a fully equipped kitchen, and two shared bathrooms per floor.

French Immersion Option

The Gaspé campus offers several programs in French, providing an opportunity for immersion.

- English-speaking students holding a certificate of eligibility (*ayant droit*) can opt for a French immersion in their specific training¹. In their case, general education² may be conducted in French or in English, along with the standard language test.
- In the case of English-speaking or allophone students not holding a certificate of eligibility, general education will take place in French, along with standard language test. The program will therefore be entirely in French.

In both cases, some restrictions apply.

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Adventure-Studies Option

The Natural Science and Social Science programs give you the option of choosing Adventure Studies, where you can explore a wide variety of outdoor activities under the guidance of experienced and passionate instructors!

Your class schedule will enable you to engage in:

- one weekly activity
- four weekend outings per semester, including a longer outing at the end of each year

Please note that English-speaking students may join the French-speaking Aventure-études group. Where necessary, instructions will be translated into English to ensure the smooth running of activities.

Example of activities

Rafting, canoeing, sea kayaking, hiking (Forillon National Park, Parc de la Gaspésie, Réserve faunique des Chic-Chocs), forest survival, board sports (cross-country skiing, alpine skiing, alpine ski touring), climbing (ice and rock), surfing, and many others.
